My Story

The story of Joseph: Living for God in a hostile world

We begin today a new sermon series looking at the story of Joseph that stretches from chapter 37 through 50 in the Book of Genesis. Joseph gives us an example of a believer who follows God with integrity in a pagan society.

Many of us are familiar with Joseph through Sunday school stories, or Andrew Lloyd-Webber and Tim Rice's famous musical 'Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat'. It has all the hallmarks of a memorable drama: intrigue, betrayal, dislocation, recovery, fame, and reconciliation. Joseph is sold by his jealous brothers into slavery in Egypt. He is falsely accused and spends years in Pharaoh's prison. Given the ability to interpret dreams by God, Joseph overcomes the odds, from being a prisoner to becoming the second most powerful man in Egypt. He manages a massive hunger relief programme, which leads eventually to reunification with his family and the saving of God's chosen people.

Whilst an ancient story, Joseph's life still has profound relevance for us today. When confronted with the harsh circumstances of life, Joseph asks those common questions. Is God in charge? Why has God caused these things to happen to me? Further, Joseph encounters common human experiences that test his devotion to God: enduring suffering and disappointment; temptation; and the challenge of forgiveness.

Whilst Joseph is certainly an admirable character, God is the hero of the story. God is the one who works through Joseph, raising up a deliverer to save his chosen people. God is the one who causes circumstances to transpire for His purposes. Perhaps of significant instruction to us, God chooses to work this time not through a priest, or prophet, or preacher, but through a man in a 'secular' job.

Apart from listening to this sermon series, can I also encourage you to delve deeper yourself. Bible study guides have been written for our Growth Groups to coincide with this series. If you're not in a group, why not get a soft-copy of the guides to study along yourself? Contact the church office.






