The Story

TRUSTING GOD'S CARE

St Andrew's is in the midst of many changes. Different people respond to change in different ways according to their temperament and character; some thrive when confronted by new and as yet unknown possibilities, while others feel stressed or worried. Whatever our individual character, times of change are an opportunity for us as a church to experience God's care and guidance:

"The LORD is my shepherd, I lack nothing."

"He guides me along the right paths for his name's sake."

(Psalms 23:1 & 3 NIV11)

Psalm 23 is a classic place to learn about God's unfailing and constant care for His people. However we feel about the future we can draw strength from this rich picture of God's provision and guidance. Bible teacher Derek Kidner sums up the message of the whole Psalm so aptly, "Depth and strength underlie the simplicity of this psalm. Its peace is not escape; its contentment is not complacency: there is readiness to face deep darkness and imminent attack, and the climax reveals a love which homes towards no material goal but to the Lord himself."

As we move through these times of change, I invite you to reflect on Psalm 23 and turn some of the promises and assurances we find there into your own personal prayers of trust and thanksgiving to God. Let me offer some other suggestions of positive contributions that you can make to the life of St Andrew's during this time of change:

- 1. Pray
- 2. Pray (yes, however you usually pray for St Andrew's I ask you to take on an additional commitment!)
- 3. Guard our Unity; Satan is not original and a common strategy to weaken churches is to attack our unity "Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace." (Ephesians 4:3 NIV11)
- 4. Press on we continue to work out our 2020 Vision as we grow up into maturity and grow in numbers, all the while continuing to learn from the scriptures, serve one another and the wider community and give generously from our time, talents and money.

"Now may the God of peace, who through the blood of the eternal covenant brought back from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great Shepherd of the sheep, equip you with everything good for doing his will, and may he work in us what is pleasing to him, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen."

(Hebrews 13:20-21 NIV11)






