The Ministry Associate Programme (MAP) is like an internship in full-time Christian ministry. The programme involves doing ministry full-time for one year and receiving training from one of the pastoral staff. It is a great way to be trained in ministry, grow in your own personal Godliness and faith, and consider if you want to pursue fulltime vocational ministry in the future.

My wife and I moved to Hong Kong in January to start the Ministry Associate Programme with St Andrews. We have a passion for ministry with people from other countries, and are interested in working in ministry in Asia long term or working in Australia with international students, so this was a great opportunity for us to try it out, whilst also being trained and getting to see how a large church in a busy city operates.

We have thoroughly enjoyed our time in Hong Kong so far, and have had opportunities to be involved in the Youth ministry, with Growth Groups, discipling people one-to-one, and starting up a group for university students. It has also been a great experience to be part of a large church which has members from all over the world.

Ministry is a very challenging, but also very rewarding experience. Its challenging because as we have spent more time in God's word and serving others, we've realised just how much we have to rely on God in every situation, even when we thought we had appropriate skills and experience! Its also hard because we are constantly dealing with sin and its effects, not just in the lives of those we minister too, but more importantly in our own lives. It is hard to be confronted with just how sinful and selfish our desires are, especially when we are trying to serve God.

But ministry is also extremely rewarding. There is nothing better than seeing people grow in their knowledge and understanding of God. Doing ministry full time has given us many more opportunities to reach our friends with the gospel, and also to encourage other Christians to grow in their faith. If you are someone who enjoys serving in ministry, then we strongly encourage you to think about doing the Ministry Associate Programme. It will train and equip you to better serve God in every area of your life, and you will not regret it!


