One Lord: Jesus Christ our Lord and Saviour. We are here to worship, proclaiming the gospel of Jesus Christ, i.e. his words and deeds, affirming Christ is the foundation of the Church, Jesus Christ is the Lord of all.

One faith: week in and week out, we are professing our faith using the words of the Nicene Creed. Through the changes and chances of this transitory life, Christ our solid rock takes us beyond our comfort zone, beyond the stormy sea, breaking through darkness and finding the sunshine beyond.

One baptism: mindful of our baptism vows before the Lord and the church. We are called by grace, in grace and through the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ. The work of sanctification, i.e. holiness of life, we are working toward the 'not yet.' Till we meet our Lord.

One God and Father of all: we received the Spirit of Sonship. And by him we cry, "Abba Father," we are heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ....' (Romans 8:15-17)

Trusting God's faithfulness, we have seen the birth of the Mandarin Children's Choir and Children's Fellowship, every Sunday 2:00pm whereby more than 10 children are experiencing growth in prayer and worship, hymns and songs, fun and fellowship.
