INTERIM VICAR'S MESSAGE

"Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever." (Hebrews 13:8 NIV)

At the heart of St Andrew's is the unchanging Jesus Christ. As a community we remain in a time of changes; Dan Evers has returned to Australia, we are appointing a new minister to oversee our daughter church in Sai Kung, Resurrection Church, and we continue praying and looking forward to the appointment of our next Vicar. In all these changes and the many others we face in the wider society of Hong Kong, such as the turmoil in policitical and financial arenas, we find our stability, strength and security in the unchanging Jesus Christ.

"The same yesterday and today and forever" is a comprehensive description. Jesus changelessness embraces all aspects of time. The whole statement may, in fact, refer to the sequence of the things Jesus does of behalf of humanity, His past sacrifice at the cross, His present intercession for us at the side of the Father and His future return at the consummation of all things.

In Hebrews chapter 13 the changelessness of Christ encourages us to be stable in our faith. The next verse, "Do not be carried away by all kinds of strange teachings." (Hebrews 13:9 NIV) encourages us to hold firm to the truths of our faith. As Jesus does not change the fundamentals of our faith in Him do not change. Inevitably, we will learn and grow and change as we live out our faith in a changing world but our foundations on which we stand and build do not change.

As we go forward in a changing world, trusting in the unchanging Lord Jesus Christ, this prayer from a few verses further on in Hebrews 13 seems appropriate for us as a church,

"May the God of peace, who through the blood of the eternal covenant brought back from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great Shepherd of the sheep, equip you with everything good for doing his will, and may he work in us what is pleasing to him, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen." (Hebrews 13:20–21 NIV)

Ressurection Church Appointment




Appointment of the Revd. Chris Ponniah as Assistant Minster of St Andrew's Church with responsibility for Resurrection Church, Sai Kung.


